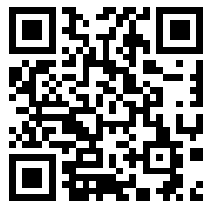

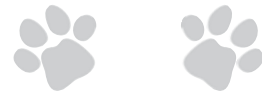

How Curwood Festival Started

The Curwood festival is steeped in tradition. Starting in 1974 as the Shiawassee River Days, this raft and boat started a 46-year long tradition. From this first race the Curwood Festival has to evolved to now include the MR Owosso Contest, The Heritage Parade, carnival rides and great carnival food. Arts and Crafts along with the encampment nestled between Curwood Castle and the Shiawassee Arts Council building there are fun things to do for all ages. This years Curwood Festival celebrates the centennial completion of the Curwood Festival, the writing studio of James Oliver Curwood. Curwood picked what he believed was one of the most beautiful and inspiring places in Owosso to place his studio.



Curwood Dog of The Year



Come and join the fun with your favorite 4-legged friend during the Curwood Dog of the Year contest. Members of the Shiawassee County Dog Development Committee will be joining forces to provide for you and your pet a “howling good time”. The profit from this event goes directly back to the dog program and the continuing improvements and upkeep to the new dog barn at the Shiawassee County Fair Grounds. Prizes will be awarded for “Best Trick Contest”, “Best Costume” (look alike or not), “Treat Seeker”, simple “Obedience Competition”, and “Obstacle Course”.

Kids in Curwood Country Parade

The Kids in Curwood Country parade has been a favorite Curwood event for many years. The parade was originally developed to give our elementary school age children a chance to march but not miss the parade on Saturday. The parade generally consists of approximately 2500 children each year. The parade is a great opportunity for our kids to strut their stuff in a parade that is all their own.

The theme of the 2023 parade is "Once upon a time". Tell us your ideas of how the 100th anniversary of Curwood Castle inspires you and how you see it playing into your visions for your fairy tale. The parade starts promptly at 7:00pm.

The parade line up begins at 6:00pm at the corner of Dewey and King Streets. The parade route begins on Dewey and Oliver and travels west to Washington Street. South on Washington Street to Exchange, west on Exchange to Ball St. The parade will turn north on Ball St and conclude at the corner of Ball and Williams Streets. The parade will disperse in the parking lot of the First Congregational Church.

The Kids parade is judged each year and cash prizes are awarded. The prizes are Most Creative, first place walking and first place float and second place for each as well.
